Cultural Humility

Promoting a culture of respect, curiosity, inclusivity, continuous learning, and advocacy for marginalized groups.

Servant Leadership

A transformative approach prioritizing the empowerment and growth of others, believing in their potential, creating a culture of trust, collaboration, and continuous learning.

Data-Driven Operator

Intentional feedback processes that seek both qualitative and quantitative data informing activities that generates meaningful decisions.

Courage to Disrupt

Proactive and fearless approach to addressing issues or wrongdoings, challenging the status quo, and advocating for change even when it may not feel popular.

Contextual in Approach

Acknowledging that behavior occurs within specific contexts, requiring a high capacity to notice subtleties before acting.

Initiators of Complex Conversations

Embrace constructive conflict, value feedback, promote critical thinking, and navigate discomfort while fostering inclusive dialogue.

Awareness of Personal Biases

Acknowledging your core beliefs, and how they either enable or limit you or others, empathizing even when you do not relate.

The capacity to understand, empathize with, and respond to the needs, emotions, and experiences of others with kindness, care, and support, demonstrating a genuine concern for their well being.
