

Permitted Uses Zoning District: Industrial - Mixed Services (IMS or I4)

Industrial - Mixed Services: Industrial areas on the edge of a main street commercial area, which are intended to provide a transition between a main street commercial area and established industrial zones. Industrial main street areas are intended to develop in a pedestrian-oriented pattern, with buildings built up to the street; first floor uses are predominantly industrial in character; uses above the first floor may include industrial, residential, or limited office uses, and where complementary uses may be allowed.
